CURRENT DTOJ STUDENTS MAY BEGIN REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER AND FALL CLASSES ON APRIL 9TH

SUMMER REGISTRATION

Your tuition payment must accompany your registration form in order to hold a place for your child. Classes and class sizes are limited. All classes are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is no registration fee required. Your tuition is refundable until May 19, 2018.

FALL PRE-REGISTRATION

Fall 2018 classes begin mid-August

Each student is required to pay a registration fee to hold a spot in a fall class. Current students pay \$10 per child. New students pay \$30 for the first child and \$10 per sibling. Each **NEW** student will receive a DTOJ T-shirt upon paid registration. *We will not have a fall schedule until mid-June, however, we do know the days and times of many of our Baby Ballet, Rhyme, Rhythm & Motion and combo classes. Register early to ensure you get the day/time you desire.

The registration fee is non-refundable.

SUMMER CLASS PREREQUISITES

Jazz I and Ballet Arts I - Students must be entering the 1st grade in the fall.

Ballet Technique - Students must be entering the 2nd grade in the fall and have at least one full year of ballet experience (combo classes do not count).

Jazz Technique - Open to any student who has completed one year of jazz.

Musical Theater - For students ages 7 and up, with prior dance instruction. At least one other dance class is required in the fall to participate.

DRESS CODE

HAIR MUST BE SECURED OFF THE FACE FOR ALL CLASSES

Ballet - Black leotard with pink tights and pink canvas ballet shoes. Skirts are permitted. Hair must be secured in a bun (unless impossible).

Baby Ballet - Black leotard with pink tights and pink leather ballet shoes. Tutus and ballet skirts are permitted.

Tap/Ballet Combination - Black leotard with pink tights. Pink leather ballet shoes and black tap shoes. Tutus and ballet skirts are permitted.

Jazz - Black leotard with tan tights. Tan slip-on jazz shoes.

Musical Theater - Any appropriate dance attire.

Dance Review - Any appropriate dance attire, bare feet.

ANNUAL NUTCRACKER PRODUCTION

We proudly announce that we will be having our 9th annual Nutcracker production on December 8 & 9, 2018. Nutcracker casting is Monday, June 4th and Tuesday, June 5th. We will be holding an informational meeting at DTOJ on Tuesday, May 29th at 8:00 p.m. A detailed newsletter will be emailed to all current DTOJ students. Students are eligible if, in the fall of 2018, they are going to be in 2nd grade or above and will be enrolled in a weekly class at DTOJ.

REMINDERS:

- Please be sure you are entering the studio parking lot by the DTOJ sign and exiting by going around the building.
- Check student name and trophy list in lobby by March 15th.
- Sign up for Father/Daughter dance by March 15th (if you want your name in the program). Rehearsal dates for Father/Daughter dance will be emailed out soon.
- March 15th: Recital fees due (\$50.00 per family).
- April 1st – April 6th: DTOJ closed for Easter Holiday.
- Picture week is April 23rd – 28th. Students come dressed in their recital costume on the day/time of their class during that week. There will be a link to the order form on our website so that you may be prepared for what is available.
- May 21st – 26th: Dance observation.
- May 26th: Last day of classes unless your class has a make-up class.
- June 1st -2nd: Recital weekend.

RECITAL T-SHIRTS

We will have recital T-shirts for sale one week prior to recital for \$16.

T-shirts can also be purchased during the recital weekend.

DRESS REHEARSALS

DRESS REHEARSALS for all RRM, Baby Ballet & 4 yr old combo classes will be held at Dance Theatre during the official last week of classes (May 21 - May 26) during their regular scheduled class times. All students should come dressed in costume as they would for recital and this is when you may take pictures and video. All 1-hour classes will be observed the last 30 min. and all 1/2 hour classes will be observed the last 15 min. of class during that week.

Dress Rehearsal (includes 5&6 yr old combo classes) will be held at Northside High School on Fri, June 1st. You will be receiving an email, as we get closer, informing you of what time your child will rehearse.

RECITALS

ALL RECITALS are held at Northside High School on June 2nd.

There will be two Mini Recitals: 9:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. on Saturday, June 2nd (includes RRM, Baby Ballet, 4 yr old combo, 5-6 yr old combo classes and most level I classes). There will be a recital list posted in the lobby by April 1st, so you can see which show your child will participate in. This will NOT be the order of the show.

JR Recital is at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 2nd
SR Recital is at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 2nd

Trophy presentation will be at the beginning of each recital. If your child is receiving a trophy this year, please take them backstage before their show. After they receive their trophy on stage, a staff member will take them to their dressing room. This presentation is the ONLY part of the recital you may video.
